- Class 1: Gooseneck Trailers (all gooseneck trailers unless the project is considered "other trailer")
- Class 2: Bumper Pull Trailers (all bumper pull trailers unless the project is considered "other trailer")
- Class 3: All Other Trailers (examples: Welding, Dump, and Towable BBQ Trailers)

Division B: Ag Machinery and Equipment

- Class 4: Truck Accessories (Grill guards, bumpers, truck beds, toolbox, etc.)
- Class 5: Tractor or Truck mounted and Pull Type Implements and Machinery (Hay equipment, farm trailers not requiring DOT, Plows and other implements, etc.)
- Class 6: All Shop Equipment

Division C: Livestock and Wildlife Equipment

- Class 7: Livestock & Wildlife Handling and Feeding Equipment (Gates, Chutes, Hog traps, all feeders, Hay rings, Blocking stands, Trim chutes)
- Class 8: Livestock & Wildlife Feeding Equipment (All livestock and wildlife feeders, Creep Feeders, Hay Rings, Deer Feeders, etc...)
- Class 9: Deer Blinds, Stands, and Observation Towers

Division D: Home Convenience and Furniture

- Class 10: Indoor Home Convenience and Furniture (Beds, coffee tables, stools, chairs, dining table, indoor benches, and indoor decorations)
- Class 11: Outdoor Home Convenience and Furniture (Outdoor benches and swings, picnic tables, Adirondack chairs, Cowboy Coolers, and any outdoor decorations)
- Class 12: Outdoor Cooking (Fire pits, non-trailer smokers, Outdoor kitchens)
