

## **Wylie FFA Points Program**

### **Objective:**

Participation points are achieved by students and parents as a reward program for their involvement with the Wylie FFA. Point values are based on the number of activities that the Wylie FFA will be hosting/involved in. Students may achieve points by participating in Wylie FFA events.

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of implementing a points system is to increase involvement within the Wylie FFA chapter and create a more familiar atmosphere for both students and parents.

### **How it works:**

Point values are established for different categories of activities. Students and parents will sign in at the event that they are participating in to receive points. Point records will be kept and verified periodically throughout the year.

### **Rewards:**

If a student reaches the 150 point mark by the February Supporter Club meeting, they are eligible to participate in the Wylie Show and Sale (Only 150 point achievers will be eligible to participate at the WSS). There is no entry fee for the Wylie Show and Sale.

### **Categories:**

Family Fundraisers – Parents and students can participate (2 parents/adults can count for 1 child)

Ex. Wylie Rodeo, etc

Student Fundraisers – Students can receive points for participating in Student driven Fundraisers (Ex Fresh Country Fundraiser). Students are required to participate in at least one fundraiser per semester to enter the Wylie Show and Sale.

Barn Clean-ups - Parents and students can participate (2 parents/adults can count for 1 child)

Student Community Service Events – Students can receive points for participating. Parents may also earn points for volunteering in the concession stand at the Collin County Jr. Livestock Stock (2 parents/adults can count for 1 child)

Supporter Club Meetings - Parents can participate (2 parents/adults can count for 1 child)

Chapter Meetings – Students can receive points for attending

Miscellaneous Points – These points can be used as make up points for students who need extra points.

- These points will only be issued by the Ag Instructor and on a situational basis.
