

Wylie Show and Sale

Ambassador Program Guidelines

- I. Selection committee, determined by the Wylie Show and Sale Board, will select 5 members from each chapter to serve as a Wylie Show and Sale Ambassador from the process outlined in section IV.
- II. Ambassadors:
 - a. Wylie FFA Ambassadors
 - 3 High School Members
 - 2 Junior Members
 - b. Wylie East FFA Ambassadors
 - 3 High School Members
 - 2 Junior Members
- III. Requirements of Ambassador Applicants:
 - a. Must be an active, paid member of Wylie FFA or Wylie East FFA
 - b. Must be passing all classes at the time of application and at the time of the Wylie Show and Sale
 - c. Must have participated in the Wylie Show and Sale at least one year prior to applying
 - d. Must be able to attend each day of Wylie Show and Sale
 - e. Must sign a contract agreeing to complete all assigned duties leading up to and during, and at the conclusion of the Wylie Show and Sale
 - f. May not have any major disciplinary infractions (suspension from school, alternative school placement) within 1 year of serving as a Wylie Show and Sale Ambassador.
- IV. Selection Process- Wylie Show and Sale Ambassadors will be selected based on the following criteria:
 - a. Application
 - b. Interview
 - c. Speech- To be presented to the interview committee and booster club during the October meeting. If selected, speeches will be recited at some point during the Wylie Show and Sale.
 - i. Topic of speech will be released each year at the time applications are made available.
- V. Responsibilities of Ambassadors
 - a. Pre-Wylie Show and Sale
 - i. Distribute flyers and posters to local businesses
 - ii. Attend at least one Business Card Exchange at the City Library

- iii. Attend 1 of the following meetings to promote Wylie Show and Sale: City Council, Wylie ISD School Board, Wylie Chamber of Commerce.
 - iv. Utilize social media to promote Wylie Show and Sale (Sr. Members Only)
 - b. During Wylie Show and Sale
 - i. Assist in the organization of set up and tear down of Wylie Show and Sale
 - ii. Serve each day of the Wylie Show and Sale, a schedule of duties will be provided once ambassadors are selected
 - iii. Sell/distribute WSS T-shirts
 - iv. Serve as the "Host Committee" for the Buyer's Breakfast on Saturday Morning
 - v. Other duties as assigned.
 - c. Post-Wylie Show and Sale
 - i. Remove Flyers from local business
 - ii. Assist in writing "thank you" notes to sponsors
 - iii. Assist in delivery of buyer's photos and letters
- VI. Inability to meet the requirements or to perform the duties outlined in the Wylie Show and Sale Ambassador Program Guidelines will result in removal from the Ambassador Program and loss of any incentives associated with this program.
 - a. If a student is removed from the Ambassador Program, they will be permitted to apply the following year

 - a. Complete the attached form and submit, in a sealed envelope, to your FFA Advisor by October 11th.
