

Wylie ISD FFA Points Program

Objective:

Participation points are achieved by students and parents as a reward program for their involvement with the Wylie ISD FFA. Point values are based on the number of activities that the Wylie ISD FFA chapters will be hosting/involved in. Students and parents may earn points by participating in Wylie ISD FFA events.

Purpose:

The purpose of implementing a points system is to increase involvement within the Wylie ISD FFA chapter and create equal expectations for all families of Wylie High and Wylie East FFA Chapters.

How it works:

Point values are established for different categories of activities. Students and parents will sign in at the event that they are participating in to receive points. Point records will be kept and verified periodically throughout the year.

Rewards:

If a student reaches the 150 point mark by the February Supporter Club meeting, they are eligible to participate in the Wylie Show and Sale (Only 150 point achievers will be eligible to participate at the WSS). There is no entry fee for the Wylie Show and Sale.

Categories:

Family Fundraisers – Parents and students can participate (2 parents/adults can count for 1 child)

Ex. Wylie Rodeo, etc

Student Fundraisers – Students can receive points for participating in student driven fundraisers (Ex Fresh Country Fundraiser). Students are required to participate in at least one fundraiser per semester to enter the Wylie ISD Show and Sale.

Barn Clean-ups - Parents and students can participate (2 parents/adults can count for 1 child)

Student Community Service Events – Students can receive points for participating in school events. Parents and students may also earn points for volunteering in chapter community service events. (2 parents/adults can count for 1 child)

Silent Auction Donations- Secure donations valued at a minimum of \$50 for the Silent Auction during the Wylie Show and Sale.

Supporter Club Meetings - Parents can participate (2 parents/adults can count for 1 child)

Chapter Meetings – Students can receive points for attending

Wylie ISD Show and Sale Ambassador- Serve as an ambassador for the Wylie Show and Sale for the 2019-2020 school year. This will include responsibilities leading up to the show as well as during and after the show.

Miscellaneous Points – These points can be used as make up points for students who need extra points.

- These points will only be issued by the Ag Instructor on a situational basis.
